



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS RANGE MAXX PRACTICE CAGE OUTDOOR 300 x 300 x 300 cm

Geleverde onderdelen:

- Tubes galvanized steel
- Clamps galvanized steel
- Cage net PE black UV protected
  - (stiff material, not easy to handle)
- Baffle net black nylon UV protected
  - (flexible materiaal)
- Tie raps black UV protected



Attention: the cage net must be fixed to the inside of the frame

Step 1: check the supplied materials and sort these

Step 2: assemble the frame as pictured on the drawing

Step 3: pull the (stiff) cage net apart and determine how it should be fitted inside the frame. The corners are marked. The stiffness of the material makes it a little bit difficult to recognize the cage shape. The mesh must be pulled until they are all 'square'; if that is the case, it will become obvious where the corners are located.

Step 4: fix the corners 1 and 2 on the picture with a tie-rap (lower front side).

Step 5: fix point 3 in the middle of the backside and after that corners 4 and 5 with a tie-rap

Step 6: fix the cage net with tie-raps all-around to the bottom tubes (from 1 to 4, 3, 5 and 2)

Step 7: fix point 6, then 7 and 8 with a tie-rap

Step 8: fix the cage net with tie-raps all around the front side (from 1 to 7, 6, 8 and 2)

Step 9: fix the corners back in the top with tie-raps (9 and 10). Attention: do not pull tight immediately! It could happen that the net does not reach until the corners due to tension. This is good, in that case a ball will never be bounced. Should 1 tie-rap be too short, please tie 2 tie-raps together to gain more length.

Step 10: fix the cage net with tie-raps to the 2 upper side tubes from 7 to 9 and from 8 to 10. You can do it, but it is not necessary to fix the net to the upper back tube.

Step 11: fix the nylon baffle net with tie-raps to the cage net. Preferably only the top side in order to prevent tension on the net. The baffle net is supposed to absorb the impact of the golf balls. This will be optimized when the baffle net will be positioned on 30-50 cm distance from the backside of the cage net and when the baffle net is only fixed on the upper side (like a curtain).
